


- International (Maritime) Crime
- Economic Upheavals
- International Conflict

#### The Costs of Disorder

- Pollution, environmental degradation and loss of marine resources.
- Loss of income for coastal states
- Instability and increased disorder
- ...and the future of the global system

# Incentives to Cooperate in MARSEC

- The scale of the threat
- Common and shared interests
- So, compromise.....

#### **Navies and MARSEC**

- Part of a Cooperative and Integrated Response both nationally and internationally

- ....unintended consequences


### **Operations Against the Shore**


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#### Soviet Desant During the Great Patriotic War
